What Makes Us Special

- Students explore a variety of STEM electives including engineering, pre-medical, gaming, herpetology, coding, web design, biotechnology, architecture, robotics, marine biology, and others.
- As the only middle school in partnership with the Central Florida Zoo, our students regularly attend class at the zoo, interact with keepers and animals, and practice common veterinary procedures.
- We offer 3 courses in aeronautics with in-depth applications of aviation, using interactive flight simulators. Students learn how planes, jets, and spacecraft fly and navigate.

Technology and the Future

All middle school students are provided opportunities to earn either a digital tool or industry certification through the completion of the following courses:

• iJourney: Students discover educational pathways offered in SCPS and develop a personalized career plan.



- iChallenge: This coding and game-based course prepares students to take AP Computer Science Principles in high school. (Semester or year-long options vary by school)
- iConnect: Students discover new possibilities and learn about technology applications and communication techniques.

- All students in 8th grade at Sanford Middle School have an opportunity to take the PSAT 8/9
- Last year, Sanford 8th graders had an average score of 896 out of 1440, higher than the Florida average of 810.
